## Frequently Asked Questions

### **What is the VMRPET grant program?**

The VMRPET grant program was established to advance the education of medical radiation practitioners and medical radiation students located, working or residing in Victoria by initiating and supporting programs and research funding that improve practitioners and students of medical radiations (radiography, radiation therapy, and nuclear medicine technology) ability to practice.

### **Who is eligible to apply?**

Eligibility is limited to medical radiation practitioners and medical radiation students located, working or residing in Victoria. This may include interstate students that are required to undertake more than 4 weeks of clinical placement in Victoria.

### **What types of projects are eligible for funding?**

Applications for funding in support of course work education programs/ research as part of a research higher degree or /workplace projects from medical radiation practitioners and medical radiation students based in Victoria.

### **How much funding is available per grant and what is the grant duration?**

At the sole discretion of the Trustee's, registered practitioners are invited to apply for either level one, level two or level three funding of up to approximately \$3,000, \$15,000 and \$30,000 respectively. Projects run typically for one year.

### **What are the main selection criteria and scoring rubric?**

Applications are evaluated based on submission of a complete application. Criteria will be assessed based on the selected Category of funding.

### **When is the application open, and what is the deadline?**

### **What documents must be submitted with the application?**

The application form will detail what information is required to be submitted. Depending on the category of funding sought, documents may include project descriptions, budget justification, letters of support, ethics approvals, receipts for accommodation or transport.

### **How do I submit my application, and can I submit a revised proposal?**

Applications are submitted through the submission portal on the website. Please ensure that all documentation is submitted at the time of application. These can include receipts/evidence of course enrolment etc. Once submitted, applicants will receive an acknowledgement of receipt.

### **What is the review process and timeline after submission?**

Applications will undergo preliminary screening, prior to panel assessment. Decisions and feedback are made within 4 weeks of the application being received.

### **How will applicants be notified, and what happens if funded?**

Applicants will be formally notified of the funding decision via email. Successful applicants will receive an official letter outlining all grant conditions, including detailed requirements for milestone reporting and the submission of regular progress updates.

Scholarship funding is only provided upon successful completion of the course/program, verified report or clinical placement.
